## Lovelace, Brant and Matchewan: Some Kinda Shake'n'Bake

Wow! It is smelling more and more like Shawn Brant is one of THEM.

First we have the old hand at Indigenous fraud, Robert Lovelace from California. He's the would-be elder of the local fraudsters who helped engineer the completely FRAUDULENT Ontario Algonquin land claim near Sharbot Lake Ontario. A phoney protest and encampment against uranium mining was staged there in 2007 by Lovelace, Harold Perry and OPP Randy Cota. It was actually a police intelligence gathering and brainwashing experiment. Lovelace apparently went to jail in February 2008 as a pretend political prisoner in order to prop up his shaky credibility.

Donna "Fasts for Fun" Dillman who sits on the Green Party of Canada's National Council is a Lovelace friend and supporter. She is not interested in getting the facts straight on Indigenous history of the area. She is a frequent speaker at environmental events where she helps to perpetuate the mythology of the phoney protests.

Then there's Benjamin Nottaway, a real Algonquin but another fraudster just the same. He followed Lovelace's jail act in December 2008. He had "friends and supporters" like Elizabeth "BrainDead" May, leader of the Green Party of Canada, protesting for him. Nottaway is another pretend political prisoner.

Nottaway's boss is old Algonquin gangster, Jean-Maurice "Pauncho" Matchewan who along with his psychological henchmen, David Nahwegahbow, Russell Diabo and others, have been robbing the Algonquins of Barriere Lake and future generations through their Trilateral Agreement, intimidation and misappropriation of community funds for over two decades.

When Shawn Brant was in jail in Lindsay (same place Robert Lovelace allegedly spent 100 days), he was interviewed by the media just as Lovelace had been. This is rather unusual for the media to interview ANYONE in jail, let alone an alleged militant sovereigntist Indigenous. The alarm bells are going off as Shawn is looking more and more like one of the fraudsters along with Lovelace, the Ardochs and their pretend opponents, the Shabots, Doreen Davis, Larry McDermott and others, one hour up the road from Tyendinaga at Sharbot Lake and the Matchewan gang across the Ottawa River near Amos in the real Algonquin territory. They'll all be putting on a show this month at the prestigious University of Toronto endorsed by the once credible OPIRG Ontario Public Interest Research Group in Toronto.

This is really a shame because Shawn worked hard for many years on the streets of Toronto helping the disenfranchised, both Indigenous and nonNative. He's been locked up several times over protests at Tyendinaga Mohawk Territory. He has demonstrated brilliant thinking

and courage that have drawn many people to him. He is an organizer and a good speaker. What has happened to him? Who are the people who really support him?

Certainly water for Indigenous communities like Tyendinaga is an important issue. Tyendinaga, right in the middle of industrialized southern Ontario where several million people live, should be able to get some attention and some results. However the economy is in a crisis and getting worse. Over 1/2 the wells in Ontario have already been polluted for decades. The water treatment facilities for western Ottawa/Kanata are not working properly. That's where 1,000's of Canada's bureaucrats, ie. the elitists' slave labourers, live and work. If the oligarchs and banksters don't care about their own workers' health, why would they care about resistant Indigenous who want to stop more development on our land?

This area is set for some mighty big changes which do indeed involve water, water diversion, that is, on a grand scale. The military expansion at Trenton Airforce base is no coincidence. The nuclear stockpiles at Port Hope and Chalk River don't just happen to be THERE. The nuclear colonialists still plan to divert the so called "wasted" water of northern rivers flowing into James Bay to the Great Lakes. While lots of water is needed for any nuclear activity, water shortages for domestic and agricultural use are increasing in the US.

Shawn Brant's appearance at the OPIRG water justice event on September 22 with Palestinian activists may make him look wild and militant. If he fails to talk about these large scale water diversions in the context of growing water shortages, if he forgets to mention the military expansion at Trenton, 20 minutes from Tyendinaga and the porta prison back on the table for Tyendinaga, if he doesn't bother to look at the bigger regional picture, then we can only shake our heads. What is he really trying to achieve? Is this some sort of a diversion of the facts?

On Friday, September 18 at the UofT, Lovelace, the Tyendinaga Support Group and the Matchewan gang aka Barriere Lake Support Group, will all be mesmerizing the students with their pack of lies about "Justice for Indigenous Communities". A few "truth" cards will be thrown in to make it all look legit.

Don't bother trying to warn the students. They'll rip off your head, their eyes glazed over with fanaticism. There's no room for dissenting opinions or reason at this higher institution of learning. This is Indigenous struggles 101 for the elitist children to learn a sanitized version of activism and participation in a socio-political cause.

For Lovelace to spout against colonialism is an absurdity. He makes a good wage at Canada's most military-oriented university, Queens in old colonial Kingston Ontario. He wants to sound like a revolutionary with his anti colonial rhetoric. How many people are taken in by his soft spoken sleight of hand magic? How long does it take for his spell to wear off?

Some of the older ones may have insight as to how previous generations of budding "activists" have been derailed from social change, whether Indigenous, environmental or political. Propaganda, Cointelpro and the drug culture threw a negative spin into people's thinking. This pretend anti colonialism is just the latest sophisticated yet crass version of colonial psychological warfare.

Will the Real People please stand up!
